

COMMUNITY COLLABORATIONS

Throughout the year we partnered with the Erie community to extend the Mission of Saint Mary's into our surrounding neighborhoods and beyond. Saint Mary's East employees sponsored an Adopt-A-Highway Program that focused on a two mile stretch of East 26th Street. Saint Mary's Adult Day Services took several fieldtrips around Erie to schools, restaurants and businesses to enhance community connections. Intergenerational programs between Saint Mary's Residents and children from local schools and day care programs were organized on a regular basis to help "foster an atmosphere of community." Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge served as the host site for monthly Millcreek Kiwanis Club meetings. Jeans Day fundraisers, held weekly, raised over \$2,900 for the Alzheimer's Association. Both campuses held educational Lunch and Learn Programs about various topics that were open to the public. Here at Saint Mary's Home of Erie, we are proud to unite with and take part in leading the Erie community as we serve out our Mission of "Loving to Care."

Technology Lifestyle FOCUSED

How do we continue to enrich the lifestyles of our Residents? At times it seems the answer may be simple: technology. Advances in technology have not only increased our ability to more effectively meet the medical needs of our Residents, but their social and personal needs, as well. Engaging experiences with technology allow Residents to connect with others, both near and far, and with themselves, as they discover new ways to explore their own interests.

- "Joey" is a computerized activity aide at each campus that helps Residents learn about technology while having fun with the various interactive programs it offers. As part of the iN2L (It's Never Too Late to Learn) system, "Joey" helps Residents with cognitive stimulation, memory care, socialization skills, maintaining independence and more.
- Saint Mary's iPads and public computers are another way Residents are staying connected with the world around them. Researching interesting facts to share with others, video chatting with distant relatives and friends, playing fun, yet challenging, games and keeping up with local and world news are just some of the ways our Residents are embracing technology.

- iPods are used for Music Therapy which helps improve the quality of life and mental well-being of our Residents. Both campuses are certified in the Music & MemorySM program which has allowed trained employees to create personalized playlists for Residents aiding in the reduction of depression, anxiety and pain while improving mood.
- Our Electronic Health Records Management system, eMAR, documents both the administration of medications and treatments for our Residents, ensuring accuracy and order follow-through.
 Designated employees can receive instant access to medical information regarding Residents through this seamless technology.
- Free Wi-Fi is offered to Residents, family members and visitors. Wi-Fi is used to provide additional ways for individuals to communicate with one another, share stories and photos of loved ones, and utilize all that technology has to offer.






